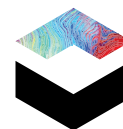

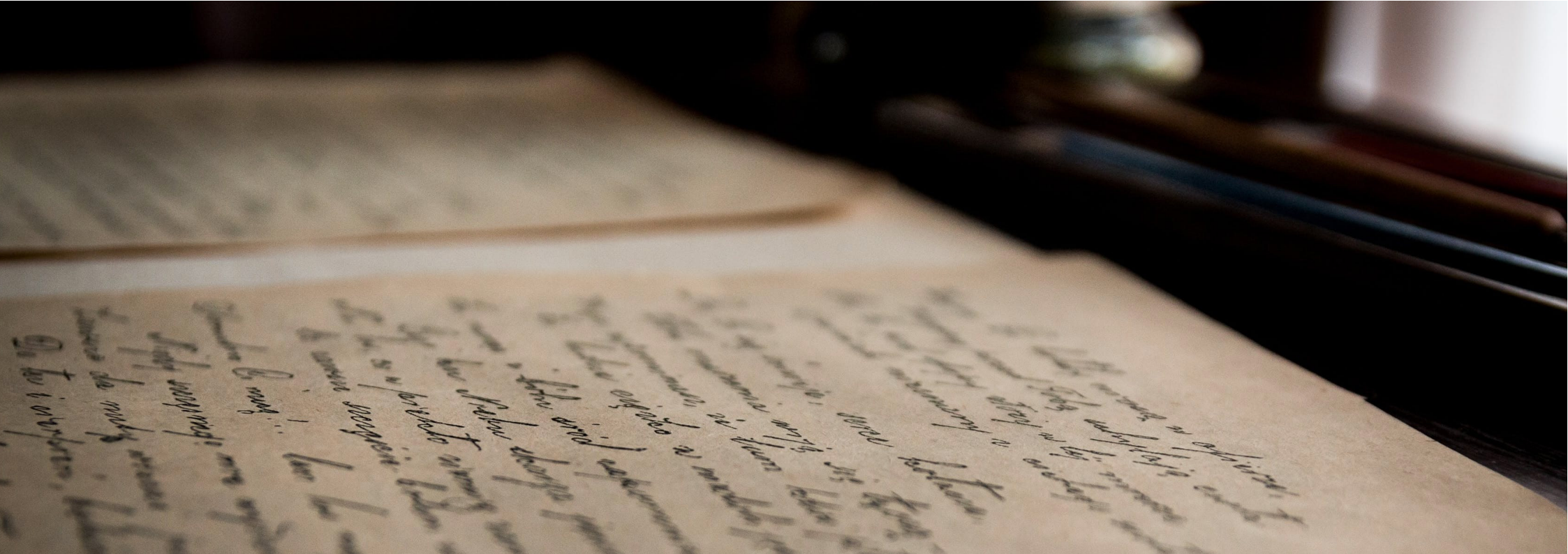

For each one of us this journey is unique, but at the same time we share a common struggle - the urge to create.

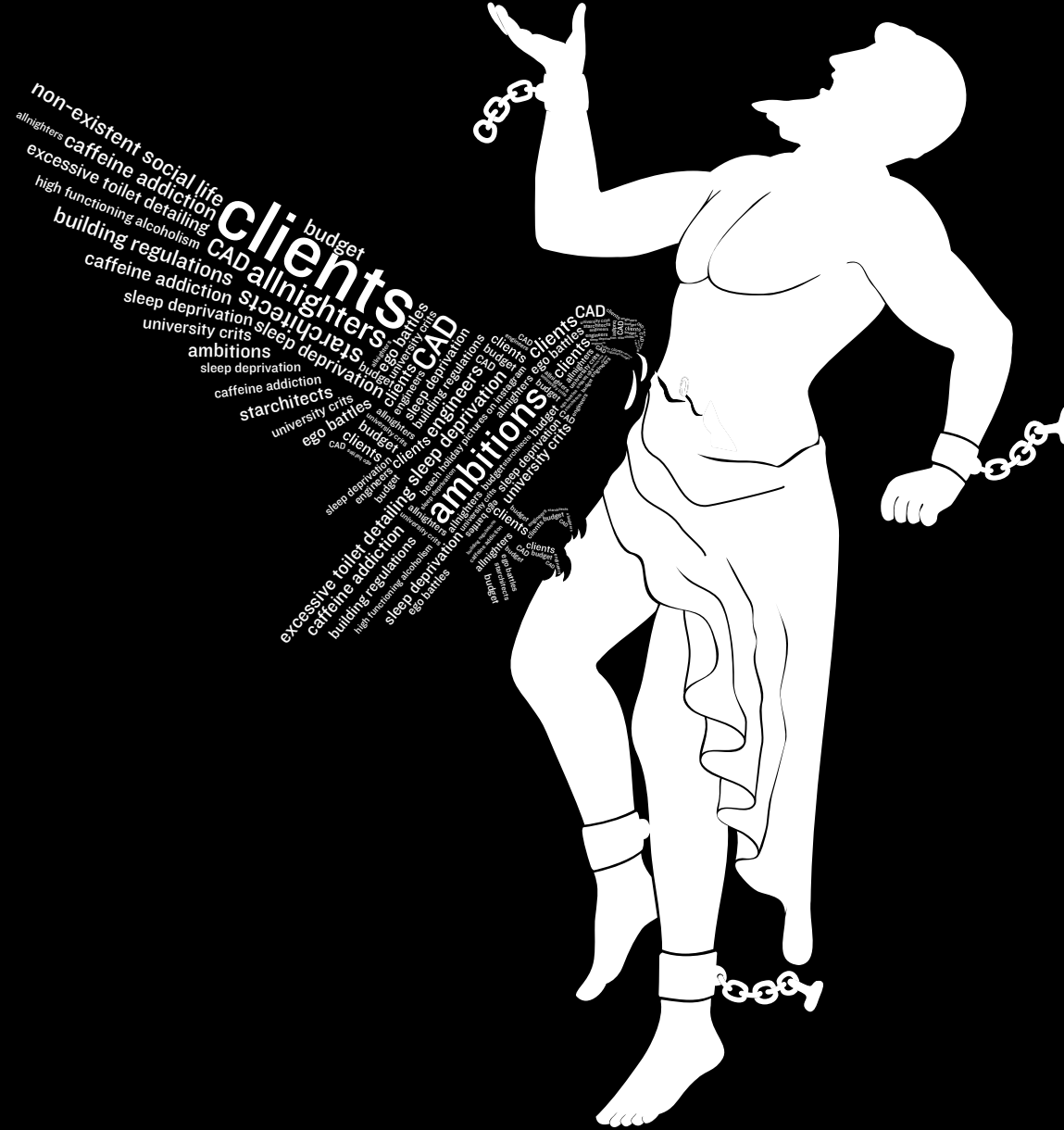
